- 1. Laurent Perrier Brut** **£68.95**
Fresh and fruity with fine discreet bubbles and subtle overtone of apples, Pears and citrus fruits.
 - Half bottle **£37.50**
- 2. Laurent Perrier Rose Brut** **£99.50**
Intensely fruity flavours, clean, well-defined and slightly sharp, the wine then opens up to provide an impression of plunging into a basket of freshly picked red berries.
- 3. Dom Perignon 2013** **£280.00**
Dom Pérignon Vintage 2013, cuvée of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, respects the company's motto: "the fullness of harmony". On the nose as well as on the palate, the wine has notes of fresh fruit, enriched by notes of sweet bakery which give it elegance.

Spumante

- 4. Marchese Antinori "Montenisa" Franciacorta Cuvee Royale** **£59.95**
Created by the interaction between the experience of the Antinori family and the demonstrated high viticultural quality of a territory, Franciacorta, the "Classics"- Marchese Antinori Cuvée Royale, Rosé, and Blanc de Blanc - are produced from a selection of Chardonnay, Pinot Nero, and Pinot Bianco grapes. The wine is golden yellow colour with a plenty of mousse and delicate, lasting perlage.
- 5. Ferrari – Metodo classico** **£49.75**
Ferrari's Trento Brut comes from vineyards located in the municipalities of Val di Cembra and Valle dei Langhi, on the hills of Trentino. The nose opens with a fresh bouquet of Golden apple and wildflowers.
- 6. Falanghina spumante DUBL – Feudi San Gregorio** **£38.95**
A fresh and aromatic wine with notes of crisp golden delicious apple, peach and floral hints of camomile, complemented by rounder notes of apricot. Captivating, fragrant and dynamic on the palate with a lively, persistent mousse and a long, pleasing finish.

- 7. Sant'Orsola Prosecco Spumante** **£25.95**
It is intense and aromatic, with hints of apple and peach blossom. A smooth and velvety finish.
- 8. Sant'Orsola Prosecco Rosato (pink)** **£26.50**
Italy is well regarded as the world's largest producer of sparkling wines. This is a beautiful sparkling pink. Dry, elegant with soft berry fruit.

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| 13. Greco di Tufo Vesevo – Feudi San Gregorio | £32.95 |
| Greco is one of the most characterful Italian whites, grown mainly in southern Italy. This wine has rich pine nut, honeysuckle and butterscotch notes which are beautifully off-set by juicy, tart green apple and pineapple fruit flavours. | |
| 14. Falanghina – Feudi San Gregorio | £30.95 |
| Falanghina is one of the unsung Italian white varieties that is fast gaining in popularity. This is a vibrant wine with plenty of richness and elegant citrus fruit. There are notes of apple and quince, alongside some nutty complexity, soft spice and a lean mineral streak through the palate. | |
| 15. Fiano – Feudi San Gregorio | £33.95 |
| Fiano is one of Italy's great undiscovered grape varieties. Straw yellow coloured with golden hues, a warm, inviting nose with elegant hints of apple and citrus fruit. Medium-bodied with a well-balanced acidity which gives freshness on the palate. | |
| 16. Gavi Di Gavi La Battistina | £33.95 |
| Delicate floral and fruity notes on the nose, with a light mouthfeel and good acidity | |
| 17. Grillo Rupe Secca | £24.50 |
| This dry white wine has an intense bouquet and lovely palate of citrus and tropical fruit flavours with refreshing acidity. | |
| 18. Pecorino Terre di Chieti | £25.95 |
| Straw yellow in colour with greenish notes. Aromas of plums and cherries that follow through to the palate. Fresh, floral and fruity. | |
| 19. Pomino Bianco - Frescobaldi | £40.95 |
| It has a straw yellow colour. The nose opens with intense floral aromas of frangipani and jasmine, enriched with fruity hints of apricot, quince and tropical fruit, followed by cardamom. On the palate it is savoury and harmonious, with a pleasant aftertaste of ripe raspberry. | |
| 20. Verdeca Talo - San Marzano | £27.95 |
| Straw yellow colour with golden hues; the nose reveals surprising aromas of white flowers and vanilla; on the palate it is fresh and mineral, with a good sapid persistence. | |
| 21. Bibi Graetz Casamatta bianco di Toscana IGT | £40.95 |
| The "Crazy-House", is our bright and approachable version of white Tuscan blend. The Vermentino brings freshness, the Moscato Bianco elevate the aromatics and Trebbiano increase the balance and the harmony of the blend. | |
| 21. Tenuta dell'Ornellaia - Poggio alle Gazze | |
| A deliciously refreshing wine with aromas of peaches and fresh apples and some toasty notes on the finish, it owes its elegant character to Ornellaia's terroir which allows it to display mouth-watering ripe fruit flavours whilst maintaining great finesse | |

Italian Wines – White

22. Leonildo Pieropan “La Rocca” Soave 2018/19 £60.75

Simply an amazing white wine. Manufactured by one of the most respected winemakers in the name of Soave. Pieropan winery has a history that dates back to 1890, is not a new name in Italian oenology, nevertheless has an eye toward the future as demonstrated by the recent changes in the company with the transformation of most of the vineyards in organic farming.

23. Antinori “Guado al Tasso” Vermentino di Bolgheri - 2020 £60.00

Straw yellow in colour with greenish highlights, the wine shows a fresh nose with aromatic notes which recall citrus fruit and flowers. The flavors are fruity and are well supported by the acidity and by mineral sensations which add savour, length, and vigour.

24. Marchese Antinori Castello della Sala “ Cervaro della Sala”

Cervaro della Sala is a blend of 85-90% Chardonnay and 10-15% Grechetto, depending on the characteristics of the vintage. The Chardonnay is fermented in French oak barrels where it ages for 5-6 months and then it's blended with the Grechetto, followed by a further 12 months in bottle before release. 1985 was the first vintage and today it's one of the most sought-after Italian whites worldwide.

25. Benito Ferrara Greco di Tufo “Terre d’Uva” 2021 £50.75

Varietally accurate aromas of ripe tropical fruit, peach and minerals. Then rich and dense, with typical chewy texture and vibrant saline acidity providing noteworthy clarity and cut. The finish is rich and tactile and features a peppery nuance.

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| 30. Sangiovese di Puglia Pasqua | £22.95 |
| The wine colour is very deep and the aromas on the nose are of rich, ripe fruit. | |
| 31. Rubrato Rosso – Feudi San Gregorio | £29.95 |
| The Feudi di San Gregorio Irpinia Aglianico Rubrato is a red wine made from 100% Aglianico grapes. This is an intense, deep wine with a classic Aglianico profile of wild black fruits, cherry liquorice and spice. | |
| 32. Nero D’Avola Shiraz (Organic Wine) | £24.50 |
| Deep ruby red colour wine with purplish highlights. Intense on the nose, with delicate fruity hints of blackberry and plum and spicy notes of cinnamon and clove. | |
| 33. Chianti Classico D.O.C.G I Leccioni Frescobaldi | £32.50 |
| DaVinci Chianti is a well-balanced wine of medium weight with jammy flavours of ripe plums, cherries and red fruit. | |
| 34. Primitivo appassimento Carlo Magno | £25.95 |
| Big and rich wine packed full of dried fruit flavours made from grapes which have been partially dried to increase the concentration and then a portion is aged in oak. | |
| 35. Ripasso della Valpolicella Villa Borghetti | £35.75 |
| Ruby-red, this wine offers intense aromas of morello cherries, but also of blueberries and redcurrants, which give way to notes of liquorice and spicy hints. A rich and full-bodied wine, with sweet and round tannins. | |
| 36. Salice Salentino – Il Pumo | £28.50 |
| Negroamaro 85%, Malvasia Nera 15%. An intense bouquet of cherry, savoury plum and spicy notes combined with an attractive hint of Mediterranean herbs. | |
| 37. Etna Rosso – Nicosia | £41.95 |
| The 100% Nerello Mascalese grapes are sourced from vines trained on the ancient 'alberello' system' on the south-east slopes of Mount Etna, at around 550-600m altitude. Delicate aromas of wild cherry with herbal and lightly spicy notes. | |
| 38. Barolo Ca Bianca | £57.95 |
| A complex nose combining plum, mulberry, ripe strawberry and leather with delicate floral and violet notes, plus hints of vanilla and spice, tannins are firm and pleasingly supported with plump fruit and a round silky texture, giving a good lengthy finish. | |
| 39. Amarone della Valpolicella “classico” – Costasera Masi | £125.25 |
| Amarone is an exclusive and unique symbol of the Valpolicella region. Corvina Veronese makes up most of the blend at 65% and the rest of the wine is Rondinella (30%) and Molinara (5%). The bouquet is raw and fruity in character with bright primary flavours of white plum, cherry and forest berry. | |
| 40. Amarone “Vigna Garzon” 2015 – Leonildo Pieropan | £112.25 |
| Brilliant and intense ruby red in colour. This is a characterful wine with a heady perfume of black cherries, blackberries and plums. The palate it is complex and rounded, with a powerful structure supporting the fruit and a lovely freshness on the finish. | |

Italian Wines – Red

- 41. Barolo “Serralunga d’Alba” 2016 – Massolino £90.50**
A full-bodied, classic and well-structured wine which ages well and perfectly represents the important character of our land. It is best to decant and serve it at temperatures between 18-20°C.
- 42. Barolo – Pio Cesare 2017 £110.75**
The 2017 Barolo is a beautifully balanced and tight expression of Nebbiolo that hits all the right spots on the palate, from the side of the mouth where you taste the acidity to the back where you get a sense of the wine's structure and integrated tannins
- 43. Brunello di Montalcino – Argiano**
Argiano's Brunello di Montalcino is distinguished by its elegance and its deep ruby red colour. It presents a good concentration on the mid-palate and a persistent aftertaste, with a rounded and voluptuous body, and interesting, silky tannins.

- 44. Brunello di Montalcino – Castelgiocondo – Frescobaldi 2010 £106.25**
Castel Giocondo Brunello di Montalcino presents a clear ruby red with garnet highlights. Pronounced notes of blackberry elegantly accompanied by floral notes such as violet. The nose is complex and well-blended: spicy notes of black pepper and clove, tobacco and leather, and "jus de viande" reflect well the evolution of the wine. Resonating tannin textures, mellow structure with a long and elegant finish.
- 45. Brunello di Montalcino 2017 – Poggio San Polo £115.50**
An intense ruby red with garnet hues. The typical aromas of violets and small red berries are followed by hints of vanilla, cedar and coffee. On the palate it is full-bodied and warm with a densely-woven texture and robust tannins, while the finish is persistent and rounded.
- 46. Brunello di Montalcino ‘Luce della Vita’ – Frescobaldi 2015 £205.00**
The citrus, dark fruit and leaf aromas are intense. Full body, polished and chewy tannins and a flavorful finish. Extremely structured and beautiful.
- 47. Chianti Classico Gran Selezione “Badia al Passignano” 2018 – Antinori £85.75**
This chianti is distinguished by a beautiful level of openness and softness (on the Sangiovese spectrum, which means you also get a bright dose of acidity).
- 48. Merlot Tenuta Guado al Tasso “Cont’Ugo” 2019 – Antinori £80.95**
The nose of the wine shows notes of plums and blueberries along with sweet spices and underbrush. On the palate, it is vibrant, long, and balanced. The harmony and the fullness of fruit on the finish and aftertaste are the characterizing traits of the wine.
- 49. Tenuta di Trinoro – Le Cupole IGT rosso Toscana £68.95**
This Bordeaux-inspired Tuscan blend opens to dark concentration and a full bouquet that is redolent of dark fruit, qualities that ultimately distinguish this wine among the many choices you have from Tuscany today.

Italian Wines – Red

50. Le Serre Nuove dell'Ornellaia – Tenuta dell'Ornellaia £95.75

This wine gives us a very pretty glimpse of what we can expect of the high-end releases from this classic vintage. The fruit is rock solid, delineated, tonic and firm.

51. Guidalberto IGT –Tenuta San Guido (Sassicaia)

Guidalberto is a blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Merlot that carries the hallmark elegance and finesse that runs through Sassicaia. This wine is the younger brother of the legendary Sassicaia and, whilst it's not quite got the full power of its sibling, it's pretty darn close - making this fantastic value for what it is. It's a wine of real concentration and structure with lots of inviting ripe dark cherry and damson fruit on the nose as well as toast and spice.

52. Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia “Bolgheri”

"Deep, bright red-ruby. Aromas of ripe red cherry, dark plum and kirsch are complicated by sexy wood smoke, eucalyptus and bay leaf. Silky and rather lush, with considerable sweetness and creaminess to its ripe, sweet flavours of cassis, blackberry jelly and ripe black plum. Finishes with fine-grained tannins and lingering notes of minerals, herbs, dried flowers and smoke. Displays lovely balance and good length on the rich, seamless, creamy-ripe finish, which exhibits a lingering menthol note that reminded me of a Napa cabernet.

53. Tignanello – Antinori

The wine offers an impeccable level of precision and laser-focus delivery of fruits, spices, tilled earth, espresso beans and Mediterranean herbs. This vintage follows the classic blending formula of 80% Sangiovese with about 13% Cabernet Sauvignon and 7% Cabernet Franc.

The 2016 wine is at the top of the list of some of the best Tignanello ever made, including the vintages 2007, 2009, 2010, 2013 and 2015.

- 70. Riptide White Zinfandel – California** **£23.95**
A slightly sweet rosé wine, juicy and fruity with luscious strawberry and watermelon flavours. Easy drinking, and pairs well with spicy food, fish, white meat or soft cheese.
- 71. Cotes De Provence Diamarine – France** **£25.95**
Pale pink, very expressive on the nose. Deliciously tangy on the palate with fresh fruit and citrus peel aromas leading to a very elegant finish.
- 72. 1932 Primitivo di Manduria – Italy** **£28.95**
A brilliant rosé colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate.

French Wines – White

- 80. Macon Lugny Louis Latour** **£39.00**
With crisp citrus fruit and softer notes of green apples
- 81. Chablis Domaine Michaut** **£37.50**
The Chablis has a fresh and lively nose with a beautiful structure, an attack is frank and good persistence.
- 82. Sancerre Domain du Pre Semele** **£36.50**
Although typical Sauvignon smell (blackcurrant buds, citrus fruits, yellow fruits), ample, supple, mineral and fruity on the palate. The liveliness is balanced against the sweetness due to a right ripeness. Smooth and fresh wine, served with grilled fish, seafood and even as an aperitif.
- 83. Chardonnay Aurele** **£24.95**
An unoaked Chardonnay with fresh aromas of lemons and tangerines, followed by a bright and zesty finish.

French Wines – Red

- 84. Cotes du Rhone la Chapele de Marin** **£24.95**
The Grenache red grape variety endows the wine with fruit, warmth and smoothness, while the Syrah confers spicy aromas, colour and a firmer structure.
- 85. Merlot Pays d'Oc, Domaine Grauzan** **£24.95**
The nose is vibrant with aromas of strawberry, blackberry and black plum. These fresh fruit aromas are overlaid with hints of spices. The mouth is well-balanced with fresh fruit notes.
- 86. Chateau Lucas, Lussac St Emilion** **£31.50**
Deep crimson red, pronounced aromas of black cherry, blueberries, plum, violet and fresh green herbs. Dry, high acidity, soft tannins medium alcohol, full body. Pronounced black fruit flavours, vanilla, cedar, leather and smoke, prunes, and notes of dark chocolate.

- 90. Sauvignon Blanc Oyster Bay - New Zealand white** **£27.95**
Pale straw green in colour with brilliant clarity, Oyster Bay Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is zesty and aromatic with lots of lively, penetrating fruit characters. A concentration of tropical and gooseberry flavours with an abundant bouquet, it is a wine that is always crisp, elegant and refreshing.
- 91. Malbec Mendoza Oscuro - Argentina red** **£24.50**
Lively red colour with violet hues. Intense aromas of fruits such as plums and cherries, well balanced in the mouth, soft and nice finish.
